no affectations, no complicated explanations for his work. He makes no effort to appear intellectual or important. He simply paints pictures that contain these qualities if you are willing to look straight. If you have a preconceived opinion of what art should be, and look for it in Paul Lantz, you will miss the fun, because he is a painter with surprises. No old routine for him, no curbing of his own spirit in attempting to catch on to the latest art phases invented by someone else, no effort to show off, no juggling, no appeal to anything but his own poetic nature. His work is creative, not contemplative, and he refuses to look backward.

He connects up through spirit and not by method or manner with a long and important list of Masters. His work has the age of the oldest and youth of the most recent. In other words, he belongs to that rare group called individuals who have through their individualities dominated through time the less animated members of the art world.

The fact that the human mind can conceive unconsciously of the creation of something definitely new without attachment to a school is in itself something to consider. But when the results are collectively and individually so intensely personal, honest and original, it is an event that not often occurs.
